

Key Points: Mike Johnson's Record on Women

- Mike Johnson wants a national abortion ban. Mike Johnson is a cosponsor of <u>THREE separate bills</u> that would ban abortion nationwide. He tweeted that doctors who provide abortion care should be "<u>imprisoned at hard labor for 1-10 years</u>."
- Mike Johnson <u>voted to shut down the government</u> on September 30th. This Congress, he has consistently fought for devastating cuts to child care, nutrition programs and more.
- 2. Mike Johnson <u>led the crusade to decertify</u> the 2020 election.
- Mike Johnson voted against the <u>Pregnant Workers Fairness Act</u> and the <u>PUMP for</u>
 <u>Nursing Mothers Act</u>. These bipartisan pieces of legislation simply give expecting moms and new moms critical workplace protections.
- 3. Mike Johnson voted against legislation codifying the right to contraception, the right to travel for abortion care, and marriage equality.
- 4. Mike Johnson voted against bipartisan legislation to protect victims of sexual assault and harassment, voting against the Speak Out Act and the Ending Forced Arbitration of Sexual Assault and Sexual Harassment Act.
- 5. Mike Johnson celebrated the Supreme Court overruling Roe v. Wade, calling it a "joyous occasion." Immediately following the decision, Mike Johnson told Fox News "There is no right to abortion in the Constitution; there never was."

It's simple: a vote for Mike Johnson was a vote against women.
